License valid from December 1 to December 31 of the year following, inclusive.

** There is a \$5.00 replacement fee for all licenses (regular and senior), plus cost of trout stamp for trout permits.

NOTE: You qualify for a RESIDENT fishing license if you are a bona fide resident of Pennsylvania. You must show positive proof of permanent residency. Senior Resident and Lifetime licenses are available to those persons at anytime during the year in which will become age 65.
