In accordance with the provisions of Section 905 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, notice is hereby given by the Tioga County Board of Elections for which candidates are to be nominated and elected at the General Primary Election, May 18, 2010, and elected at the General Election, November 2, 2010, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. prevailing time. The following are the public offices to be elected at the General Election, November 2, 2010.
